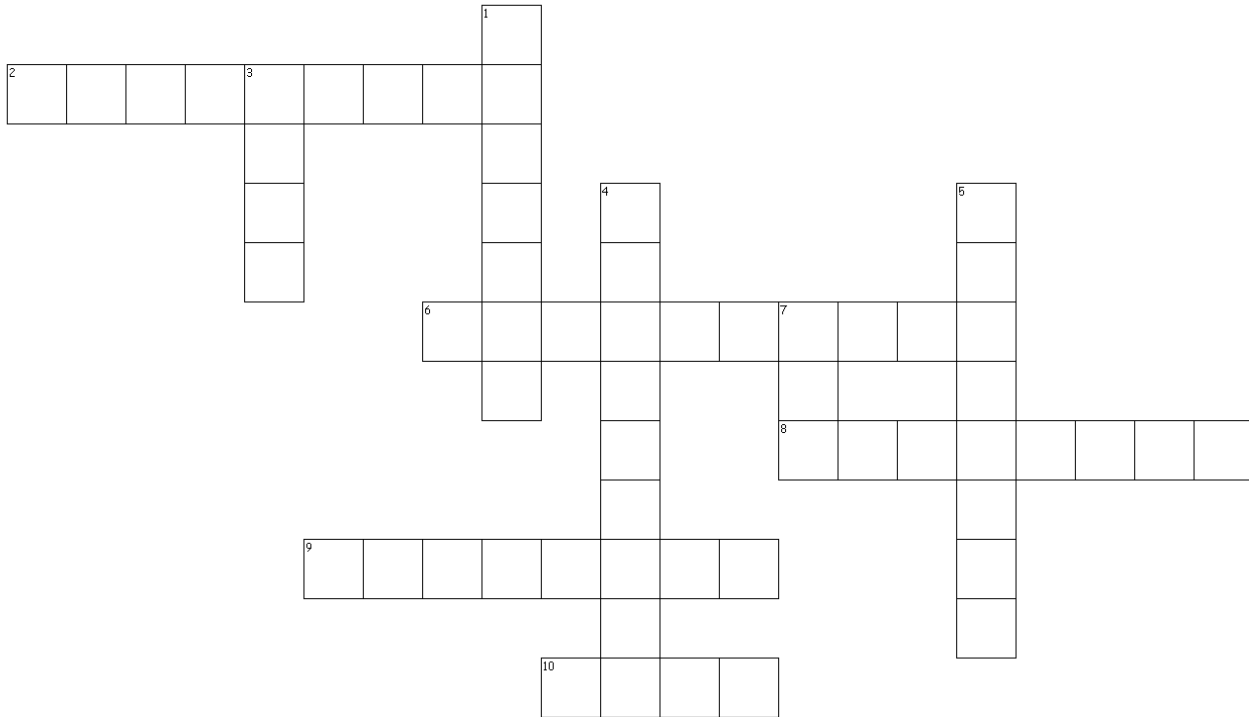

ACROSS

2. Method of creating an image on a pot by applying colors to leather-hard pottery, then scratch off parts of the color to reveal the clay color underneath.
6. Liquid colored clay used to decorate ceramics and is usually covered with a clear glaze.
8. Hitting a clay wall with a thick, flat piece of heavy wood while supporting the other side.
9. Cut out of a pot profile for checking form while shaping.
10. The narrow part at the top of a pot.

DOWN

1. Building a form with long, rolled out pieces of clay.
3. The base or foundation of a ceramic piece.
4. Clay which has dried completely and is ready to be fired.
5. Preparing clay so it has the correct consistency for building.
7. The part of a pot which juts out over the neck.
